Dear Parents,

As many of you will be aware, the government have recently announced their plans to open schools for more of the 'Key Worker' families (as first priority) from week beginning 1<sup>st</sup> June. In order to offer provision for more pupils across the school, we will require more accurate registration for those who are attending the key worker school provision. Unfortunately, we still have pupils arriving at school who have not booked places via our Parents Evening Booking System which is hindering our ability to plan effectively for those groups.

Therefore, we have had to change our requirements:

- Child places **must** be booked a week in advance using the link below:

- If a child arrives at school without a booking we reserve the right to turn that child away
- Those who are repeatedly arriving late or without a booking will no longer be able to use the service
- If you have any problems or require a last minute booking/change, you must email [admin@netleyabbey-jun.hants.sch.uk](mailto:admin@netleyabbey-jun.hants.sch.uk) as soon as possible.

## **Half Term Week**

In order to be prepared for the increase of pupils from the week beginning 1<sup>st</sup> June, we require the support of our local community and families **to close to as many as possible** during the week of half-term (25<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> May). This will then enable us to start to undertake the level of cleaning required across the entire school, as well as organising our systems which will be required to keep the larger number of pupils and staff safe on their return to school. We ask that you only book for the half-term week if your working circumstances are such that you have **no other alternative**. We will be minimising the number of days that we can offer this emergency provision to prepare for our wider opening, so please be mindful that the Bank Holiday Monday (25<sup>th</sup> May) will not be an option for booking.

We would like to say a huge thank you to those who are using the booking system effectively, you are really supporting the working of the school in these extremely difficult times.
