Cycle/Scooter Permits - Summer Term

We will be issuing **Summer Term** cycle/scooter permits for children who wish to cycle to school in the following way:-

- Children aged 10 and over who have completed their Hampshire Bikeability Level 2 Certificate for their cycling proficiency will gain a permit if they wish to cycle after the course. (These are run by the school during the year.)
- **Until then all pupils must be accompanied by an adult when cycling or using a scooter.**
- Children who live further away from the school will gain priority.

The permits will be valid for this term only so that as many children as possible have the opportunity to cycle during their time at school. **Helmets and high visibility clothing must be worn when cycling to school.**

Permits will be issued as soon as possible. If you do not receive a permit this term we will retain your request slip for the next round of permits depending on numbers.

Although the cycle shelter will be locked you may wish to consider providing an extra bike lock for increased security.

May I remind you that children should not be cycling in pedestrian areas (especially the blue bridge) and **cycles/scooters should be dismounted at the school gate and walked into the shelter.** Failure to comply with this could result in the loss of the permit.
