

Netley Abbey Junior School Sports Day - Thursday 28th June

Dear Parents


Our sports day will take place, weather permitting on Thursday 28th June, unless you are contacted otherwise.

Children will need to arrive at school as normal; they will get changed into their PE kits at school after registration. Please ensure that your child comes with the correct colour PE top (Moons - blue, Asteroids - red, Comets - green and Stars - yellow).

This year's Sports Day will aim to run from 9.15am to 11.45am approx. and comprise of two halves like previous years. We will start with a carousel of athletic activities including running, jumping and throwing, finishing with competitive more formal style events. The children will be competing in houses to encourage participation by all and will travel around in house teams.

9.15 - 10.45 Carousel

Parents will be asked to spectate around the perimeter of both carousels; this will ensure you can see your child perform, whilst keeping the safety of all paramount. You may like to bring blankets or parasols for spectating.



10.45am - 11.45am Running Track Events

There will be a 15 minute changeover period where equipment is moved and the children who wish to spectate will be relocated to the 75m track to sit in their house teams. If the weather is excessively hot, all children not participating in the running events will be brought back in to school.

Parents will, as last year, spectate from the middle of the field facing the 75m track.

The competition is scheduled to start at 9.30am and due to finish by 12pm, when the results will be announced and the winning house crowned Netley Abbey Junior School champions! After the competition has been completed, children will return to school for lunch and afternoon lessons.

On the morning of sports day, we appreciate your support by providing your child with two bottles of **water**, a healthy snack (as the kitchen will not be selling break time snacks as usual) and sun protection. It is advised that children wear at least factor 30 sunscreen and reapply when necessary (please ensure all bottles are labelled). Children may also wear a hat if appropriate for them.

On the day we would request that you refrain from stepping into the carousel area/track or giving your children extra snacks during the morning. Adults will be able to purchase refreshments, which will be provided by the 'Friends of Netley Abbey Junior School'.

We look forward to having an enjoyable day and hope to see you all on Thursday 28th June!
