Year 5 Trip to Winchester Cathedral – Thursday 14th June

As part of our History subject we are studying the local area of Winchester. For this study we are planning a trip to Winchester Cathedral, which will take place on 14th June. Within this visit, the children will be having a tour of the Cathedral, learning about key people involved with the Cathedral and understand the influence of the Cathedral on the city of Winchester and the history behind this iconic building. They will also learn about the Anglo-Saxon King Alfred and more recent significant people such as William Walker.

In order for the visit to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £7.50 per child to cover the cost of the visit, including coach travel to Winchester and activities run by the staff at Winchester Cathedral. We are lucky that the Friends of Netley Abbey Junior School are also subsidising a proportion of this trip. Please be advised that should insufficient funds be raised for the trip, we will unfortunately have to cancel. Children will need to:-

- Wear school uniform (plus appropriate outer clothing).
- Bring a healthy packed lunch in a disposable bag so it can be thrown away. Children who are entitled to free school meals may order a packed lunch on the attached permission slip.
- Bring a water bottle (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles!).
