Dear Parents,

Firstly, we would like to thank you for your continued support with your child's home learning this term: we have really enjoyed seeing children's posts to Seesaw, including their BBC Bitesize tasks and spelling and times-tables practice, along with other exciting activities.

I am writing to let you know that, from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June, your child will have a variety of transition activities to complete as part of their home learning, which will be uploaded to their current Seesaw class. They will have three transition activities each week, up until the end of term:

- one based on the Netley Learning Model;
- one with a focus on mindfulness and wellbeing;
- and one designed to tell them a little bit more about the year group they are moving into.

This will include letting your child know about exciting trips and activities coming up, showing them the classrooms they will be taught in, and introducing them to their new year leader and class teacher!
