Transition Project – The Point

Next week in school, the Year 6 children will be taking part in a local cluster transition project, organised by the 'The Point' in Eastleigh.

The children will receive a range of letters that have been written by Year 7 pupils from The Hamble School: the letters include helpful advice about how to prepare for their time in secondary school, and aim to support the children with any worries that they may have.

Year 6 will have a chance to read through these letters and pick out the key points. They will then choose one letter, which they will practise and perform as a monologue, thinking carefully about how they can use body language and vary their voices for effect. These will be recorded using digital software.

The Point would then like to use these videos to share with other schools, and may share them on their social media platforms.
